The successful candidate shall report directly to the Lake Babine Nation Health Director.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Interview clients to obtain case history and background information for intake reports
- Assist clients in finding more options to develop plans of action while providing necessary support and assistance
- Meet with clients to assess their progress, provide support and discuss any difficulties or problems
- Provide Family Violence prevention workshops/meetings, crisis intervention. emergency shelter services
- Implement and organize the delivery of specific services within the community
- Maintain contact with other social service agencies and health care providers involved with clients to provide information and obtain feedback on clients' overall progress

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Completion of a college or university program in social work, child and youth care, counselling or other social science or previous work experience in a social service environment as a volunteer or in a support capacity
- Understanding of relevant legislation, policies and procedures
- Understanding of the northern cultural and political environment
- Ability to speak and understand Babine Carrier (preferred but not required)
- Provide a criminal record check.
