SUPPORTED CHILD DEVELOPMENT WORKER

The Supported Child Development Worker provides support to children in their developmental journey and to families and childcare centers to help them enhance the child's development. ASCD enables children who require extra support to be included in a childcare, preschool or after-school setting.

The Supported Child Development Program is a community-based program that is designed to specifically meet the needs of children ages 0-18 years that require extra support in a childcare setting or home-based setting. Supported Child Development is grounded on the belief that inclusion, early intervention and support is important during the early stages of development.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Support children with extra support needs to fully participate in the childcare setting
- Encourage and model social interaction with the child(ren)'s peers
- Plan and implement daily activities, and experiences to meet goals and objectives
- Provide culturally appropriate daily experiences that support and promote the development of all children in the setting
- Maintain regular communication with parents
- Complete daily notes as required
- Prepare reports as required (i.e. monthly, annual)
- First Nations Culture and traditional knowledge
- Familiar with Provincial Child Care Regulations
- Possess sound developmental assessment skills and well versed in intervention techniques
- Ability to work independently and within a team setting at the Woyenne Daycare
- Excellent oral and written communication skills to compose business correspondence
- Maintain confidentiality concerning employee files
- Ability to prioritize, manage time, organize, multi-task and maintain focus despite interruptions

QUALIFICATIONS

- Early Childhood Education Basic and Post Basic Education; or post graduate courses related to child development and special needs (e.g. Child and Youth Care, Social Work, Psychology) with minimum two years' experience; or a combination of education and experience may be considered
- Occupational First Aid Level 1
- Regular outdoor work is required, including during inclement weather
- May be required to lift up to 60lbs
- Criminal Record Check Required
- Must possess a class 5 driver's license and reliable transportation
- Medical clearance, as per Child Care Licensing Regulations
- Basic computer skills including, but not limited to, Microsoft Office 365
