FAMILY PRESERVATION WORKER

*The objective of the **Family Preservation Worker** is to strengthen the safety and well-being of First Nations families by engaging, supporting, and providing culturally appropriate preservation services that are in keeping with the best interests of the family. They are responsible for planning, developing, implementing, and coordinating the delivery of Family Preservation Services to LBN families. This individual will work with the community to provide a holistic and traditional approach to services.*

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provide specialized home and community-based support and preservation services to families.
- Deliver programs that promote healthy lifestyles.
- Assist in the coordination of community development and educational services.
- Respect and protect the rights of clients
- Keep up to date on the issues facing the Native community; including but not limited to changing legislation.
- Support clients with problem solving, compatibility, and conflict resolution.
- Promote the integration and acceptance of clients in the community.
- Provide services in a way that is consistent with the philosophy of the organization.
- Understand and use correct reporting procedures for serious or unusual incidents
- Respect and protect the privacy of information relating to all company clients, employees, and business affairs.

- Two (2) years of experience working youth and families.
- High level of critical and logical thinking, analysis, and/or reasoning to identify underlying principles, reasons, or facts.
- A strong understanding of First Nation issues and community practices.
